David Ross's painting often includes a whimsical side, especially in the form of bunnies doing everyday activities in their own special way. His demo will focus on the use of bunnies or other creatures to question or highlight human activity (whether mundane or dramatic) without offending his viewers. He will also demonstrate his painting style which incorporates watercolor and ink with thick layers of acrylics and oil pastels.

David returned to his art after retiring from a career in education. He graduated with a B.S. in Art Education from the University of Oregon with a strong emphasis on studio arts (painting, drawing, printmaking). While earning his Master's Degree in Education at Portland State University, he spent two years studying graduate-level slab, sculptural and throwing techniques to be able to translate his drawings into works of clay.

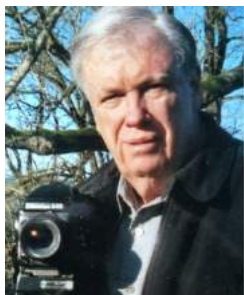
